

## **Cannock Christadelphians - Website Privacy Policy**

As an individual visiting our website (cannockchristadelphians.org.uk) your privacy is very important to us.

This Website Privacy Policy explains how we use any personal data we collect about you.

### **Who are we?**

We are the Cannock Christadelphians who meet together as an 'ecclesia' at 21 Price Street, Cannock WS11 0DS. We operate independently from any other Christadelphian ecclesia or organisation and have our own arranging committee. As a group of likeminded baptised people, we believe in the word of God, recorded for us in the Bible – old and new testaments, in full. Our purpose is to help each other to be more Christlike whilst we wait for Christ's return to establish a worldwide Kingdom here on earth. This includes reading and learning from the Bible and remembering Christ with emblems of bread and wine, as instructed.

We also want others to know about God's plan and purpose, and His promises to all who will search to live in accordance with His requirements. To that end we invite others to learn about God and His son, Jesus the Christ by:

- Invitations to Bible talks and other similar events
- Invitations to Sunday school and other youth activities
- Reading information provided by posting leaflets or by direct request

### **How we collect and use information about you**

Invitations to learn about God's ways are made by various means, including information on our website. Contact forms are posted on our website for you to make enquiries or to request specific information. The personal data you provide by using the enquiry forms or the email address are directed to one location to ensure central control, and only used to respond to your enquiry. We do not use cookies to collect your personal data. Unless you request otherwise, we will not:

- use your details for any other purpose
- pass your details to any organisation outside Cannock Christadelphians
- visit, call or text you

### **The information we hold about you**

We will keep your details on record for up to 24 months, at which point your details will be deleted from our records. Your details will also be deleted within 14 days of your emailed instructions to [enquiries@cannockchristadelphians.org.uk](mailto:enquiries@cannockchristadelphians.org.uk)

### **Access to your information, and correction**

We want to make sure that your personal data is accurate and up to date. You may ask us to correct or remove information you think is inaccurate.

### **Complaints**
