What we believe concerning...

... resurrection. It is the way in which those who believe God and try to obey Him will receive everlasting life. The Apostle Paul wrote, **"The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."**^a Jesus himself stated, **"I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me, though he may die, he shall live."**^b To those who denied the resurrection, Paul wrote, **"if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen...but now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep...Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at his coming."**^c And Paul stated categorically to the Athenians, **"(God) commands all men everywhere to repent, because he has appointed a day on which he will judge the world...by the man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."**^d
